

OUTSTANDING WOMEN in NEUROSCIENCE Award 2022

Call for nominations 2022

The CRC 1436 opens the first call for the new Outstanding Women in Neuroscience (OWN)-Award.

We are pleased to announce that the CRC 1436, founded by the DFG, awards young female scientists for outstanding achievements in the field of Neuroscience. The prize will be awarded annually, starting this year. The award will be presented at the CRC 1436 General Assembly on September 27th, 2022, and is endowed with € 5.000.

Nomination procedure:

The award is conferred to talented and passionate female scientists at Postdoc level and young PIs of the CRC 1436 who have made significant and recognized contributions in Neuroscience.

We would like to invite qualified individuals from the CRC 1436 to submit applications. Also, all CRC-members are eligible to nominate qualified individuals.

Criteria:

- Completed M.D. or PhD with up to 7 years of experience after completion (career breaks will be taken into consideration)
- A scientific track record showing great promise and an excellent research output
- Recognized public engagement and excellent scientific communication
- Supervision of team members and students

How to apply or nominate:

- A complete application/ nomination includes a one-page justification (no more than 500 words), a tabular curriculum vitae, and a list of publications of the candidate.
- Applications/ Nominations may be submitted to Julia Rödiger (<u>Julia.roediger@med.ovgu.de</u>) by e-mail from now until August 12th, 2022.

Selection process:

The candidates will be assessed by our Steering Committee based on the written applications/nominations.
